

# Abolition of Slave Trade.

**T**HE Africans, and descendants of Africans, residing in Boston, propose to celebrate, on the 14th day of July inst. the auspicious era of the Abolition of the traffic in Human Flesh, in *Great Britain* and the *United States*; which commenced in both nations, on the 1st January, 1808. A procession will be formed near Elliott Street, at 11 o'clock in the forenoon; and will proceed through the principal streets, to the *African Meeting House*; where the Rev. Dr. *Morse*, of *Charlestown*, will deliver a Discourse suitable to the occasion. The celebrators will then dine together.
